Comprehensive Clozapine Training

Program Aim

The aim of the program is to provide participants with an understanding of all aspects of clozapine education in relation to the Therapeutic Goods Administration Clozapine Protocols, SA Health Clozapine Management Clinical guideline, drug interactions, side effect management, Adverse Event Protocols and provide information regarding the SA Health Nurse Led Clozapine Clinics and associated standardised documentation.

Eligibility / Entry Requirements (refer to flyer)

For nursing staff no partial attendance is available for this course, both days must be completed in their entirety. For pharmacy and medical staff sessional attendance may be negotiated on request.

For SA Health nursing staff, a compulsory 4 day supernumerary placement with a community clozapine coordinator will be required in order to receive the certificate of completion. This placement has Clinical / Co-Director approval; it is to be completed in a 4 day block Mon – Thurs. The placement is to be negotiated with line management. Regional LHN participants complete a combination placement within the metro LHN Clozapine Clinics and within their home team. Regional LHN participants also have the option of completing the Long Acting Intramuscular Injection (LAI) training during the metro placement. There is an expectation that following completion of the training participants will be available to relieve community Clozapine Coordinators.
